



 Sealing

 Sealing is required prior to grouting

 Cleaning and Maintenence

 Protect from harsh abrasive cleaners and tools

- We recommend sealing all natural stone products with a penetrating sealer and sealing all porous non-polished stone (limestone, tumbled marble, etc.) prior to grouting. This prevents grout from staining or affecting the color of the stone. Stone is a natural product, and care should be taken to protect it from harsh abrasive cleaners and abrasive cleaning tools.
- White thin-set or mortar is required: light limestones, tumbled stones, "antiquated stones", and light-colored marbles.
- Likely identified with dry seam, pits, fossils, and glass veins that are often filled at the factory. The fill may perhaps leak through the voids. In this case, refilling these voids may be a necessary maintenance procedure.
